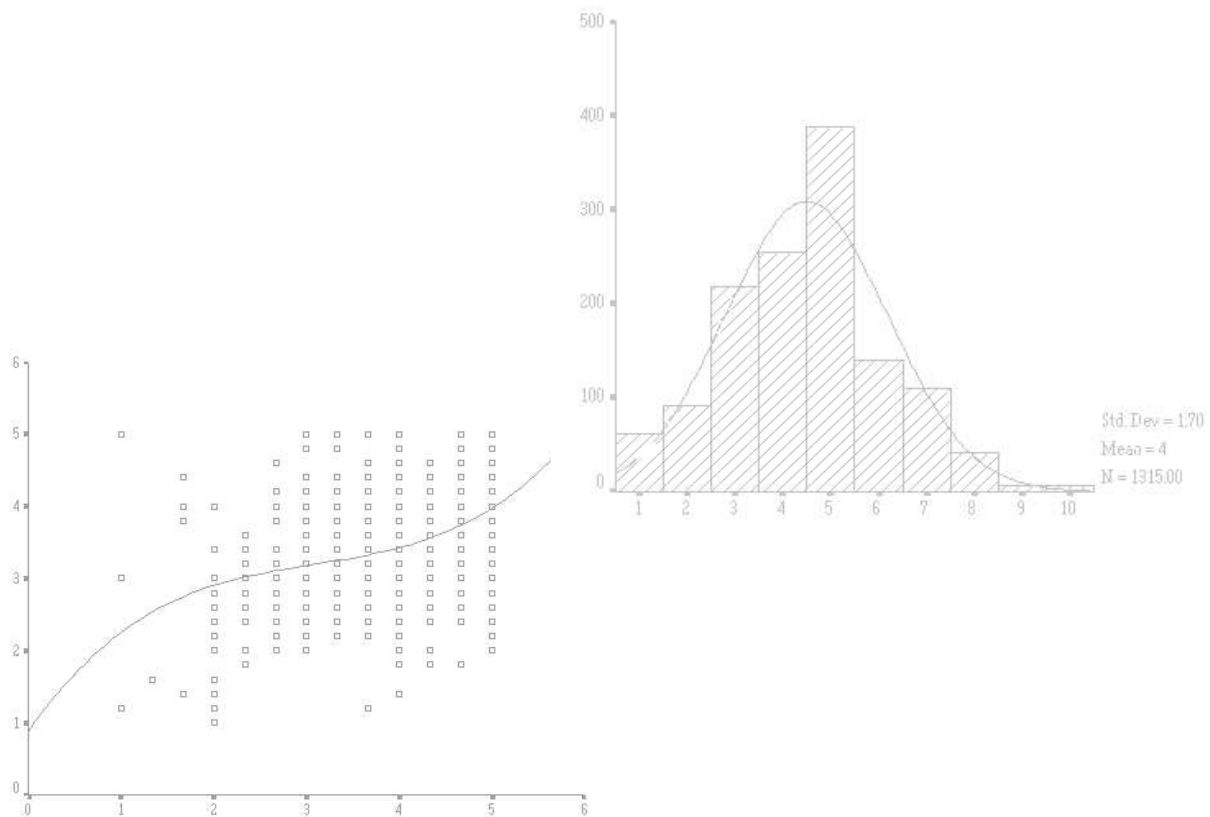


# 2007 Korean General Social Survey



**Survey Research Center, Sungkyunkwan University**

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The Survey Research Center (SRC) at Sungkyunkwan University is currently conducting the Korean General Social Survey (KGSS), an annual national sample survey funded by Korea Research Foundation (KRF). 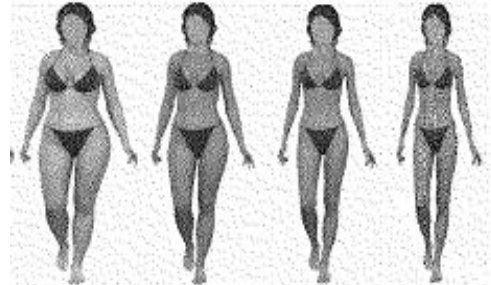
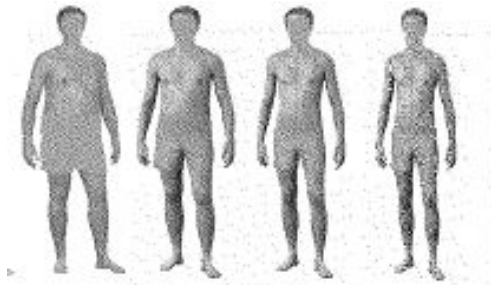
